Our Pre-School

Rising Fives Pre-School Group was established in 1972 and is run by a committee of parents. We are non-profit making, which means that all of our income is spent on running and improving the setting. We own our own building, next to the old school in Whitchurch, Hampshire.

Curriculum and Structure

We follow the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) curriculum and develop the skills, experience and knowledge of the children through fun, stimulating activities which are based on the needs and interests of our current group. We encourage children to pursue their own interests and to design or select their own activities, but also have times when the group comes together and adults lead the activities. This balance is vital to meeting all of the needs of the children and helping them to prepare for school.

Staff

The Committee employ a manager, Sarah Pritchard, who takes care of the day-to-day running of the preschool. Sarah is a qualified and experienced Early Years Teacher and works with our team of caring, friendly staff, who are on hand to care for your child at all times.

Opening Times.

Rising Fives is open in Hampshire School Term Times, with the exception of 5 INSET (staff training) days each year.

Children who attend between 12.15-12.45 have the option of bringing their packed lunch and eating it with us at Rising Fives. For children who stay all day, a packed lunch is essential. All sessions include the opportunity to have a healthy snack and a drink.

All sessions are subject to availability.

Fees.

All children are entitled to 15 hours of pre-school education, paid for by Hampshire, from the start of the term following their third birthday. We can advise you when this will be for your child.

All attendance that is not covered by funding is charged at £4.25 per hour (correct at Jan 2015, subject to change).


